general decoupage instructions

1. Stain or paint wood pieces to match paper or leave natural and seal. You only need to paint the surfaces that will not be covered by paper.
2. Place paper face down on work surface. Place wood piece face down on paper. Make sure wood piece is positioned over the part of the paper that you want to show on the front.
3. Trace around wood with exacto knife, cutting the paper as you go or trace with pencil and cut with scissors.
4. Apply a layer of decoupage medium with a sponge brush to the front side of the wood. Place paper cutout onto the wet glue, line up edges and rub down. Remove wrinkles and bubbles by pressing gently with a popsicle stick, working from the center out.
5. Apply another coat of decoupage medium on top of complete project to seal. Allow time to dry.
6. Lightly sand around edges of the wood to sand off excess paper.
7. Adorn with 3D accents and ribbon.

warm your heart cocoa packet

A heartwarming gift for neighbors, friends, teachers - just about anyone!

1. Fold chipboard along score lines, folding in on each side to form a book and folding top flaps down toward inside of book.
2. Adhere paper to chipboard with glue or decoupage medium, covering the front, back, inside, and tops of flaps, refer to photo for paper placement. (We didn't cover the underside of the flaps, since they don't show.)
3. Adhere a length of ribbon to the outside of packet right in the middle, leaving enough ribbon extending on front and back to tie packet closed.
4. On front cover, add a 1 ½ inch strip of Cold Weather Stripe along the bottom. Tie ribbon to the clip portion of Snowman Jumbo Clip and glue to front of packet, referring to photo for placement.
5. On the inside, punch a small hole in the center of each flap, and also in the top center of each cocoa packet. Thread metal snowflake on a brad, then insert brad through hole in flap AND cocoa packet and secure. Tie packet closed and you're done!

warm and cozy mitten plaque

The cutest place to hang those mittens, hands down! 22 x 7 inches

1. Paint edges of large board and edges and front of smaller board to match patterned paper.
2. Adhere paper to large board, following General Decoupage Instructions.
3. Apply vinyl lettering to smaller board. Starting with "mittens," pull backing off so the vinyl stays on the sticky tape. Lay "mittens" down on wood where you want it, centering carefully. Rub vinyl down firmly using a popsicle stick or edge of a credit card. Slowly peel off backing, leaving vinyl in place. Repeat with "cozy and warm," centering over "mittens."
4. Add brackets from Cool Tags Cardstock Die Cuts to each side of vinyl words, as shown.
5. Adhere smaller board to the center of large board.
6. Adhere clothespins to bottom of large board.

frosty the snowman candy shaker

It's like Frosty came to life and brought candy! So cute, he'll melt your heart.
8 x 12 inches

1. Stain or paint edges of wood pieces to match patterned paper. For main body, be sure to also paint the inside edges of square opening. Seal the inside edges of square opening with any clear sealer found at your local craft store. This makes the shaker safe for hard candy. Paint entire nose piece orange.
2. Decoupage paper to wood following General Decoupage Instructions. Refer to photo for paper placement. We used the brown stripe on Funky Snow Stripe for the hat.
3. Line Plexiglas pieces up on front and back and screw into place. You may want to start the holes with a thumbtack. Make sure not to overtighten the screws because the pressure may crack the Plexiglas.
4. Glue hat and scarf in place. Glue nose on. Add small button eyes and a large button to scarf. Pour candy into shaker through hole.

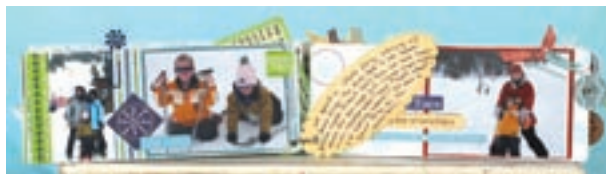

let it snow tag album

This album is “snow” much fun! Fill it with photos of a favorite ski trip, or making snow angels in the yard. It will fill your heart with warm winter memories. 10 x 4 inches

1. Brush edges of clear texture sheet with white acrylic paint. Using a glitter glue pen, color in the snowflakes on the back side of the template, where the design is indented.
2. Adhere Cold Weather Stripe to “snow” word chipboard, following General Decoupage Instructions. Remember to place paper face down, place chipboard face down on paper, then trace and cut with scissors or exacto knife.
3. Cover each chipboard tag (front and back) with patterned paper.
4. Add photos to each page, trimming photos to assorted sizes and shapes. Embellish pages with metal accents, cardstock stickers and ribbon.
5. Using Cool Tags Cardstock Die Cuts, add journaling to go with each page. Embellish backs of tags with cardstock stickers.
6. Assemble album as shown, alternating pages and journaling tags. Add ribbon to metal ring.

quite the pair *wood mittens*

No matter where you hang them, these mittens are sure to warm your heart (but probably not your hands). 6½ x 8 inches

1. Paint edges of mittens and chipboard snowflake various colors to match patterned paper.
2. Decoupage paper to wood following General Decoupage Instructions.
3. Remove long blue and brown scallop frame from Cool Frames Cardstock Die Cuts. Cut in half lengthwise (down the center of blue stripe). Punch circles out of brown scallop. Add a length to top of each mitten, as shown in photo.
4. Tie ribbon at top of each mitten.
5. Adhere the yellow scallop square from Cool Frames Cardstock Die Cuts to the upper left corner of one mitten. Glue a small clothespin to the yellow square and use it to attach a photo. Attach Snow Jumbo Clip to chipboard snowflake and glue to outside edge of second mitten.
6. With a staple gun, attach each end of a length of ribbon to the center top of each mitten, so they hang together.
